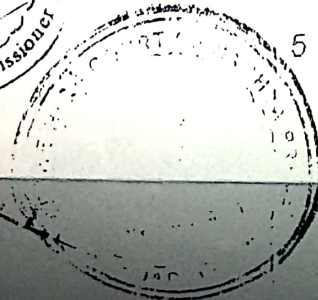

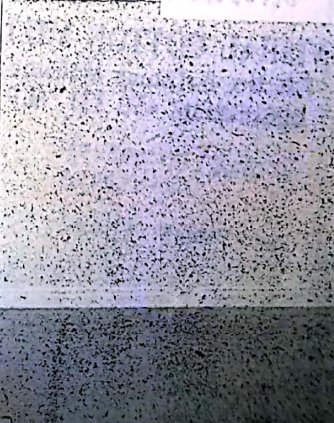

	In W.P.No. 281/2002, the Division Bench of Indore High Court passed the following Order on 13/2/2002 :	
	"....Looking to the urgency in the matter, it is directed that slaughtering of animals at a public place during the Mela period commencing from 17-2-2002 to 28-2-2002 shall not be done by the respondent Nos. 4 to 8 and anyone connected with organising the said Mela, if any, such slaughtering of animals is noticed by the respondents No. 1 to 3, then they would take appropriate action in the matter against such person and would comply with the aforesaid order in letter and spirit...."	
	In the present case, issue is similar though temple is different. Accordingly, we direct as follows :	
	Subject to hearing otherside, on whom notice has been served lastly by the petitioner, in the writ petition and interim relief, it is directed that there shall not be slaughtering of animals at the temple or around it or in connection with organizing of Mela or any kind of Pooja-religious ceremonies in whatever form /name it may be assigned.
