ORAL ORDER (PER A.A. DESAI, J.):

1. By this public interest litigation the petitioner has principally canvassed a grievance in relation to the cruelty to the animals on large scale. Mr. Tated appearing for the petitioner urged the slaughtering of animals continues at public places which poses danger to the public health. Moreover there has been ugly exhibition of the slaughtered animals at public places which obviously affects the decency and tranquility. He therefore urged that there should be complete prohibition as envisaged by law, however, the District Authorities, may be Collector or Superintendent of Police, are not taking proper steps to deal with the manage. This has created a public nuisance.



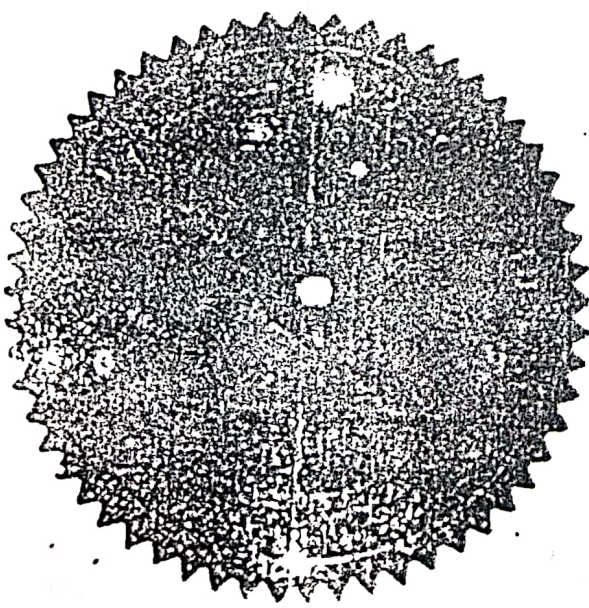
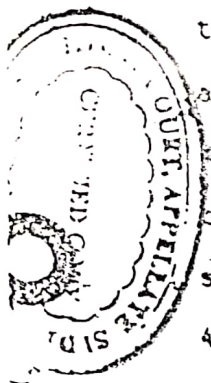

7. The petitioner was heard from time to time. This Court also passed the interim order. Today we have heard Shri C.J. Sawant, the learned Advocate General on behalf of the State. Having regard to the circumstances and the grievance as canvassed, Mr. Sawant, the learned Advocate General made a statement, that the State Government shall issue instructions to the District authorities through out the State to take stern action against the persons carrying any slaughtering or indulging in slaughtering for the purposes of trading at any public place. Mr. Sawant further made a statement that such directives will be issued to the concerned authorities within a period of ten days.

8. In view of the statement, according to us, the grievances of the petitioners are substantially satisfied. Petition is accordingly disposed off.
